GUIDELINE HOW TO REGISTER MEMBERS AND DANCERS

MASTERSOFT SYSTEM

Dear WADF Member,

The WADF is using the MASTERSOFT system to register its members, where each member has a special login to gain access to the Database to register its dancers and from this same register enrol dancers to WADF World and Continental Championships.

The Members area can be found by clicking on the "Members Area" button when visiting our website www.worldartdance.com. The following is what you will see.

Home

The first line "Request for Membership" is open to everybody who would like to become a member of the WADF. All new Members will receive a login, username, and a password from the Membership Department. By clicking on the second line, "Edit details of Member" and using the login it is possible to update everything regarding the member details. Contact person, addresses, phone numbers, email addresses, web sites and similar. It is important that each member updates their details regularly.

To register its dancers the Member must click on the fourth line, "Register New Dancers", and again use the login. It is very easy to register each dancer. As an example, this is what the DO-Serbian Dance Sport Association will see after log in. Fill in name, date of birth and Gendar.

Always enter FIRST NAME and FAMILY NAME of competitors.
Date of birth, type of format (Day.Month.Year) Example: 06.09.2004

Write the first name of the dancer first, followed by the Surname (family name). Remember that it is only possible to use English letters. No Russian or Czech letters that are not in the English alphabet or Scandinavian letters like å,ä,ö or ü can be used.

Write the birth date 8 digits and remember the dots after the day and the month.

Then tick the gender circle male or female and click on "register", (which is not visible on the picture).

The Age category comes up when you click on "register button"

A pop-up sign will appear to confirm that the registration was successful, only then is it possible to upload a photo of the competitor, which should not be larger than 150 x200 pixels in size. It is advisable to take photos of all competitors who you want to register and download them into your computer. See that they are saved in the right size and then it is very easy to upload the photos one by one.

To edit details of dancers, click on the "Edit Details of Registered Dancers" login and find the dancer you want to edit. The system is very easy to use and if you have any problems, please ask by sending an e-mail to WADF@telia.com Below you can see a special GUIDELINE on how to pay the license fee for dancers and how to enrol them for competitions. At this moment, please register your dancers who want to participate in competitions coming up soon and then one by one register all your competitors. It is also possible to use this system for National Competitions.

Manual for Members how to handle the dancers license fee.

To make it possible to enrol dancers to WADF World and Continental Championships, the Member must be an active member, meaning having paid the membership fee. At Recommended and Recognised competitions there is no license fee to be paid.

At WADF World and Continental Championships a member will then be able to enrol his or her dancers to but first must the dancers also become active, meaning having paid the dancers license fee.

When a member registers his or her dancers in the Data base those dancers will get a "grey" background in the dancers register. The dancers is then a Supportive dancer. To be able to enrol a dancer to a WADF World or Continental Championships, the background has to be coloured pink. The Finance office will handle that procedure in the following manner.

The Member goes in to our web site www.worldartdance.com and do as follows:

Click on "Members area"

- 1. Go to EDIT DETAILS OF REGISTERED DANCERS
- 2. Log In with username and password
- 3. Select dancers using X column
- 4. Go to "Selection" and chose "marked"
- 5. Click on List
- 5. Click on "Send e-mail"
- 6. Click on "Ok" I am sure
- 7. Tick the box how you want to pay the license fee
- 8. Click on "Ok"
- 9. The Financial office will turn the dancers on the list from "grey" to "pink" and it is then possible to enrol all dancers that are marked pink to WADF World and Continental Championships
- 10. The Financial office will send an invoice to the Member who can pay the invoice in three different ways.
- a/ By credit card in the License shop
- b/ By Bank transfer
- c/ Cash at the competition. If you chose to pay cash there will be a 10% money handling fee put on top of the invoice. (Please bring the invoice to the WADF Supervisor for the event if you are paying cash. The whole invoice has to be paid by one person. It is not possible to pay parts of the invoice by different persons like parents or competitors).

Note

In order to avoid a lot of cash having to be transported and the cost of handling cash, we would very much appreciate if the license fee is paid by Credit card or Bank transfer before the competition. It will also make the "check in" at the competitions so much easier.
