The beginning

- The World Artistic Dance Federation the WADF was registered as an "Ideel förening" in Sweden the 3rd of April 2013 by Nils-Håkan Carlzon.
- The WADF is a non-profit, non-political, democratic Worldwide dance organisation, with a dedicated enthusiastic leader team who together have almost 200 years of experience in the Art of dance.
- We learn from the past, we live in the present and we look for the future!

This is our mission

- To create a real democratic honest World Dance Federation where everybody that like to become a member can be accepted as a member without having to go through the "one member per country".
- To create an International forum for Dancers, Choaches, Dance school owners and Dance club Trainers where it is possible to discuss and develope dance competition disciplines in an modern and innovative way.
- The WADF accepts that the Art of dance is much more than Dance Sport competitions. There are two parts to be considered. In the WADF events the dancers are evaluated in both the Technical merit and in the Artistic merit. Artistic competitive dancing is first and foremost Art and Culture.

Our Mission

- To give all dancers the chance to compete at International competitions without having to be elite dancers. To give all girls that did not found a boy to dance with a chance to be a team member in a Duo, Trio or a Small or Large team were also second and third rated dancers can fill a place.
- To offer our members competitions from 7 main Departments containing 24 Dance Divisions including 56 competition Disciplines in 10 Age groups and 7 Categories ending up to more than 10.000 possible combinations.

Members

- At present time the WADF consists of 1.250 members from all 5 Continents.
- There are 43.000 dancers registered in our members registers.
- There are two kinds of Members. The Branch members which are Federations, Associations, Organisations who have their own members and the Single members who are Dance schools, Dance Clubs, Teams, Corporate businesses and Individuals
- The Members register dancers in our website that participate at WADF events.

Membership fee and license fee

- When Members apply for membership its free of Charge. They apply as Supportive members
- They may register dancers in their register and they may participate at Recommended and Recognised WADF events without having paid the membership fee or dancers license fee.
- When taking part in Continental or World Championships the Members have to pay the membership fee and the dancers participating must pay the dancers license fee.

Membership fee and license fee

- The membership fee for a Branch member is 250 Euro.
- The Membership fee for a Single member is 50 Euro
- The license fee for a dancer is 10 Euro
- From the date the fee or license is paid, its valid one complete year plus a bonus period to the 30th of June if paid in the first part of the year or to the 31st of December if its paid in the last part of the year.



WADF Academy Medeltest system

- To ensure that there is a continuation of new pupils wanting to start to compete at WADF events, we offer the Members Worldwide a possibilitie to organise Medaltests On-line where a highly qualified expert will examine the pupils in the School or Club.
- The Age system is the same as in the Competition rules, Mini Kids, Juveniles, Juniors, Youth and Adults.
- There are 6 levels. Brons, Silver, Gold, Brons Star, Silver Star and Gold Star.
- The possible disciplines to be examined in are the same as in the Competition system. To ensure that we will find the right Expert Examiner, the examination will be conducted for a special Department. Couple Dance, Street Dance, Stage Dance, Acrobatic Dancing.
- Many Schools and Clubs have pupils from Different styles meaning that it is possible to combine two Departments like Stage and Street or Couple dance and Street dance.

WADF Academy Medaltest system

- The examiner will establish a standard norm of a performance by a dance school pupil of the same age as the candidate.. The examiner will then give marks from 1-100 in two criteria, Technique and Artistry compared with the standard norm.
- The standard norm established by the examiner will be valued as 50 points. If the Candidat being examined will perform a less skillful performance than the standard norm, the Candidat will be given a mark below 50.
- If the Candidat being examined produce a better dance performance than the expected standard norm, the Examiner will give a higher mark than 50. The better performance the higher the marks.
- All dancers taking part in the Medaltest will have Diplomas with their given marks on. The teacher or owner of the School can buy Medals and/or Trophies of her or his own choise if they wish and each Candidate has then a choice to buy the Medals from the School/Club.
- The Medaltest Examination fee to the WADF for the School or Club will be set from time to time by the WADF.
- The Examination fee for the pupils to the School or Club will be set by the teacher or the owner of the School or Club.
